Did you Know

On March 27th the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act was signed into law. The CARES Act increases tax deductions for charitable donations for both individuals and corporations for tax year 2020. You may wish to consider the following provisions when determining your charitable gift this year.

Individuals who do not itemize their tax deductions may now have a new “above the line” charitable tax deduction of \$300 per tax payer (\$600 for a married couple). An “above the line” deduction reduces a donor’s adjusted gross income and thereby reduces taxable income.

Individuals who do itemize may deduct up to 100% of their 2020 adjusted gross income, up from the previous limit of 60%.

Corporations may deduct up to 25% of taxable income, up from the previous 10%.

To qualify for these special deductions, contributions must be made during the tax year 2020. Payments on outstanding pledges also qualify, providing the payment is made in 2020.
